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

(a) testing conditions: Fluid pressure = 60 bar / 870 psi Viscosity = 25 s (CA 4) or 50 mPas.s

Handle air pressure = 1.5 bar / 21.75 psi Temperature = 20.5 °C / 69 °F

Note: For HVLP compliance, the maximum inlet air pressure at the gun handle must not exceed 12.68 psi (0,87bar) to maintain 10 psi (0,68 bar) or less at the air cap. Testing for HVLP compliance was performed using the specified HVLP test air cap, the fan control fully closed and a pressure gauge on the air inlet fitting at the gun handle. It may also be a requirement of some regulatory agencies that users have the appropriate test air cap available on site to verify that the gun is being operated within the regulatory limitations.

Assembly: Remove the cap located at the end of the fluid tube and install a swivel fitting instead of it. Tighten the fitting with the wrench.

A fitting is supplied with the gun. Install a fitting at the outlet of the gun air regulator. Connect the gun air hose on that fitting.


## **Testing conditions:**

Gun handle air pressure = 1,5 bar / 21.75 psi Viscosity = 45 s (CA 4) or 120 mPas.s

Temperature: 20°C / 68° F

Distance between the gun and the surface to

be painted: 20 cm / 7.9"



## 2. REMOVAL - REASSEMBLY



#### **WARNING:**

Before any action on the spray gun, shut off the compressed air supply and depressurize the systems by triggering the spray gun.

#### SEAT (64)

Remove air cap, then unscrew seat-holder (63) by means of the wrench (72) supplied with the spray gun.


Clean the inside of the spray gun. If necessary, replace by a new assembly (refer to spare parts, ind. 62 & 64).

Loosen screw (66) by means of a screwdriver, take off the seat (64) and replace it.

Replace the seat as shown opposite (tightness cone towards the needle). Do not forget the seal of the seat (65) for the MVX 120 and MVX 200 spray guns.

Reassemble in reverse order.

Screw the seat-holder with the wrench provided by respecting the torque indicated at paragraph: "Assembly instructions".



## ■ NEEDLE AND CARTRIDGE (20)

Remove seat-holder (62) as indicated previously.

Remove trigger (53) by taking off the screw (55) and the spindle (54).


Remove pin packing (23).

Push needle frontwards while pushing the back part of the packing.

Push needle with packing out of body core.

If required, replace them (refer to spare parts).

Reassemble in reverse order.



#### AIR VALVE ASSEMBLY (25)

Remove the gun trigger (53).

Remove the seat-holder (62).

Unscrew the sleeve (60) from the needle line.

Unscrew the needle spring (61), the needle strainer (33) and the needle rod (32).

Take off the air valve (25) by pushing it at the back of the spray gun.

Take care of spring valve (31).

If required, replace air valve assembly (refer to spare parts).

Reassemble first valve, trigger, needle rod, valve spring, needle strainer, needle spring, then sleeve.

**○** Be careful with the orientation order of the needle rod. Assemble the <u>smaller</u> diameter to the needle line sleeve.


#### ■ REPLACEMENT OF AIR VALVE SEAL (29)

Remove air valve (25) - (refer to previous paragraph). Take off the seal (29).

Place the new seal (29) in its housing. Lubricate it. When reassemblying:

Carefully, insert the valve into the gun body carrying out a rotary motion so as to preformate the valve seal (29).

Reassemble the other parts as previously indicated.



## ■ REPLACEMENT OF SCREEN (49)


Unscrew the swivel fitting (68) located at the gun handle.

Unscrew the screen support (49).

Make the filter slide (48), change it or clean it.

Change the seal (47).


Reassemble the parts in the reverse order of the disassembly sequence.




## Before reassembling the different components :

- Clean the parts with the appropriate cleaning solvent with a brush.
- Install new seals after having lubricated them with PTFE grease.
- Install new parts if necessary.
